Pre-finished by hand, this Oak has a textured bright and timeless look and feel that fits a chalet or summerhouse. After brushing and fuming, we bleach it with our own custom lye which gives the patina long-lasting protection against yellowing. The wood is treated with hardwax-oil and can be soaped and reoiled time after time to nourish and protect the surface patina.

American white Oak (Quercus Alba) mainly over 80 years old. Grown in responsibly managed forests in the northern states of the USA.


Professional maintenance with our Maintenance Oil will make this finish richer and protect it over time. Spot repairs are possible with our touch-up kit.
